## OUR 5TH ANNIVERSARY GALA

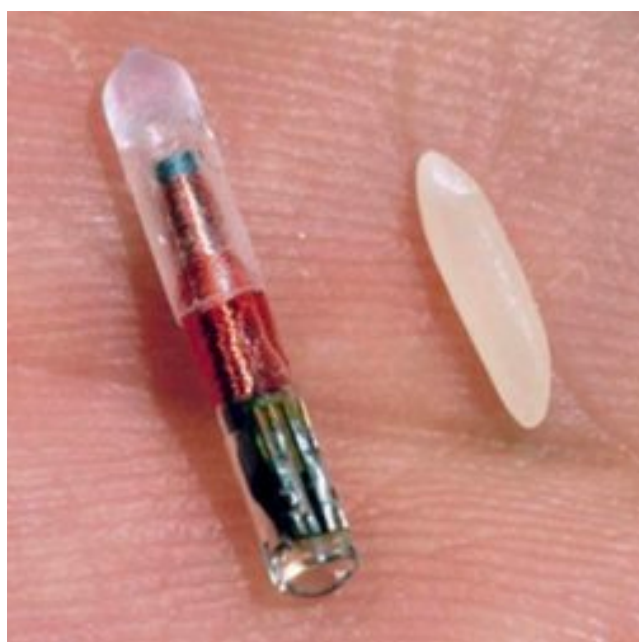
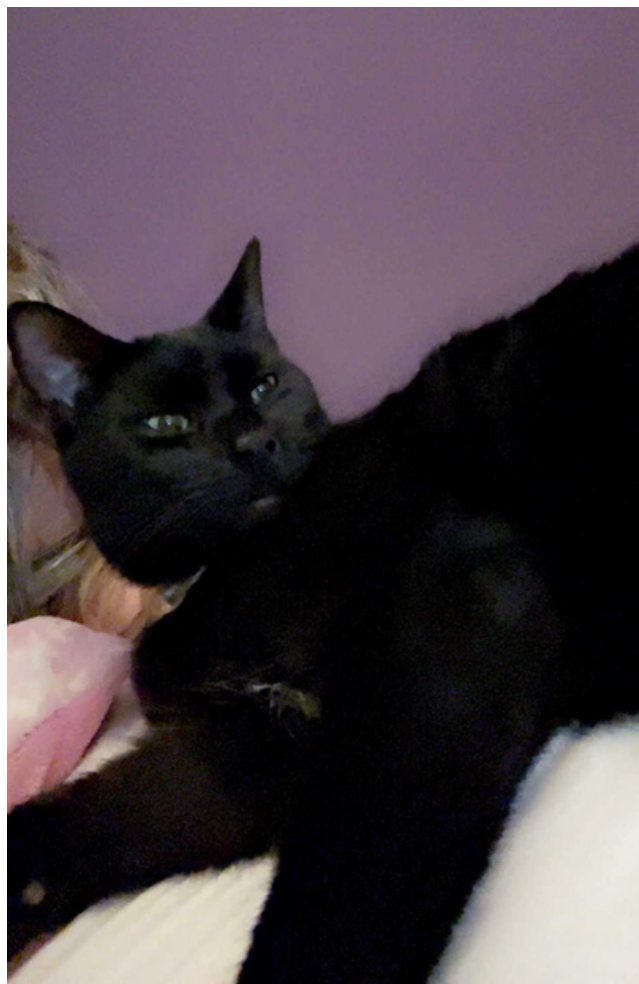


October marked Pittie Party's 5th anniversary and incredible milestone of 1000 lives saved. We celebrated with an elegant gala benefit at the Hyatt in New Brunswick, where 100 volunteers, donors and their guests dined and danced the night away. A very generous supporter covered the cost of the event, and proceeds from ticket sales went directly to Pittie Party. The highlight of the evening was an exciting basket raffle featuring 40 themed baskets donated by local businesses. From gift cards for pet boarding to a wine tasting and dinner for four, the raffle prizes raised more than \$6500 for our rescue. The Grand Door Prize was a Night in New Brunswick and included a free night for two and breakfast at the Hyatt New Brunswick, tickets to a comedy show and dinner at a local restaurant. The gala was financially beneficial to Pittie Party—providing food, services and medical care for our cats—as well as a priceless team building experience for our volunteers.



# MICROCHIPS SAVE LIVES!

We pride ourselves on microchipping every cat that passes through our rescue, and for good reason! This October, one of our adopted cats accidentally got out of the home when visitors left the door open. Poor Patella was missing and despite flyers, social media posts and extreme efforts she was unable to be located. Thanks to her microchip, Patella was found safe and sound by a Good Samaritan nearly 10 miles from where she originally disappeared, and she had crossed the border into a different state! If Patella hadn't been microchipped the chance of her being reunited with her family would have been almost nonexistent. A microchip is a small RFID chip that is about the size of a grain of rice and is implanted just under the skin between the shoulder blades. This important device stores the contact information of the owner of a pet, and is critical in reuniting lost pets with their owners. Microchips are something that we all hope we never need to use, but we are extremely grateful for when it's needed.

Hana is a chatty and affectionate girl who loves attention and people! She purrs nonstop and loves to snuggle and play. She especially loves chasing string toys! Hana is a special needs cat; her back legs are partially paralyzed. But she doesn't let that slow her down! She loves to run and play (and even climb!) like any other kitten. She needs assistance going to the bathroom, which she tolerates very well. If you're interested in being Hana's furever home, Pittie Party will provide you with resources about caring for paralyzed cats and can answer any questions you have.

Adoption fees for our animals are \$150 for cats older than 6 months and \$175 for cats younger than 6 months. The combined adoption donation will be reduced by \$50 when adopting more than one cat. All of our adopted cats come with health records and are dewormed, vaccinated, tested for FIV and FeLV, spayed or neutered, and microchipped.
